

POCKET JUGGLING

INTERACTIVE STREET CIRCUS

30 min, non-verbal, for all ages

Have you ever wondered what is hidden in the pockets of passers-by on the street?

A curious blue pickpocket reveals the contents of his many pockets, filled with imagination, dreams and sometimes nightmares, before searching through audience's pockets for the necessary materials to build a juggling grand finale.



The show explores the boundary between public and private space. Through daring yet respectful clowning, the audience becomes an essential part of an unexpected juggling adventure made of 5 balls, 7 pockets and 2 or 3 hands.

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TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS: Flat area 5 x 5 m, minimum height 5 m, preferably at the same level as the audience. Best suited for public spaces such as streets, parks, squares and open urban environments.

TRAVEL: Can travel by plane, train and bus. Solo performer, compact luggage.

MORE ABOUT THE SHOW

Wearing a blue worker's costume covered with pockets, the protagonist resembles a migrant worker from the Balkans, a vagabond earning money by busking in public space. Objects, hands and pockets begin to behave unpredictably. We expect another ball, but whose is the third hand? What happens when a pocket starts moving around the body?

Through playful and daring interaction, audience members gradually reveal fragments of their own private worlds. Everyday objects 'pickpocketed' from spectators transform into improvised stories and eventually, through a small act of magic, into juggling balls, leading to a suspenseful finale.

The performance plays with trust, intimacy and the invisible social rules of public space. After all: am I still a pickpocket if you publicly allow me to reach into your pocket?

Pocket Juggling also expands the possibilities of contemporary juggling as throws and catches intertwine with hands disappearing into pockets, creating new choreographies and rhythms.

The show was created in 2023-2024 during a land journey across Europe, Turkey, Iran, Pakistan and India, combining influences from different cultures along the way.
